- 1.Off cut from quilts don't go into the garbage (collect and trade scraps, use the scraps for filling dog bags, trim up scraps into 5.5" or 2.5" squares to use)
- 2. Donate your fabric to charitable organizations
- 3. Make cloth bags and use them for shopping
- 4. Use scraps for dog bags
- 5. Use LED lights to save electricity
- 6. Use your clothes to make memory guilts or legacy project
- 7. Shop for clothes or fabric supplies at thrift stores
- 8. Support companies that are making an effort to have sustainable processes
- 9. Be aware of the origins of the fabric you are purchasing
- 10. Decide if you want to buy organic. If you do, how much of your purchases will it be?
